2015 Year 7 – 12 Contributions, Charges and Fees

Parents/Guardians

This leaflet is to provide you with financial information about payments and charges for 2015 at Coodanup College.

The total amount of Voluntary Contributions parents and carers are being asked to pay has been contained to \$235 per student. This is the same amount which can be claimed through the Secondary Assistance Program for those parents/guardians who are eligible.

If your child chooses to do an additional cost option subject in Years 7 – 10 such as, but not limited to, Specialist Football or Music, these charges are **compulsory and must be paid**. For students in Years 11 and 12 all subject costs are **compulsory and must be paid**. Please refer to the 2014/2015 handbooks as a guide to most costs involved in Years 11 and 12.

2015 SECONDARY ASSISTANCE SCHEME - Public Schools

The Western Australian Department of Education provides an allowance to assist eligible families with secondary schooling costs. To be eligible for the allowance the parent/guardian must hold a Centrelink or Veterans' Affairs card which lists the student as a dependant.

The allowance consists of two components:

\$115 Clothing Allowance paid directly to the parents/guardian. Please bring in Bank Account details e.g. BSB and Bank Account Number.

\$235 Educational Program Allowance paid directly to the college. Any compulsory charges will be an additional cost to the parent/guardian, as this is not covered by the Secondary Assistance Scheme.

Parents/guardians in receipt of the ABSTUDY School Allowance from the Department of Human Resources (Centrelink) are not eligible for the Secondary Assistance Scheme. Alternatively, they can apply for the ABSTUDY Supplement Allowance.

Applications for these allowances for students enrolled in Years 7 – 12, must be completed by the parent or guardian in **Term 1 prior to the closing date of Thursday 2 April 2015**. Applications cannot be processed after this date.

SECONDARY ASSISTANCE CAN BE CLAIMED AND CONTRIBUTIONS AND CHARGES PAID AT THE ADMINISTRATION OFFICE BETWEEN 8.00AM AND 4.00PM DAILY FROM MONDAY 2 FEBRUARY 2015 OR ALTERNATIVELY 8.00AM TO 6.00PM THURSDAY 5 FEBRUARY.
