

2022 Good Standing Policy Year 11 & 12

At Coodanup College, we believe that a person’s education forms the foundation for a successful future.

It is our vision to foster a supportive community that empowers students to explore their strengths, dare to dream, and discover the positive impact that they can have on their own lives, the lives of others and that of the wider community. The Good Standing Policy encourages students to make positive choices, take responsibility for their actions and encourages positive behaviour to help students succeed in further education or employment.

WHAT IS GOOD STANDING?

All students commence their courses with Good Standing status. Maintaining Good Standing requires:

- Satisfactory attendance (i.e. above 85%) with all absences explained.
- Completion of all assessment tasks on time
- Satisfactory behaviour and dress

WHAT IS ADVANCED STANDING?

Students can achieve Advanced Standing by consistently meeting the College’s expectations and contributing “extra” to the school community. Students can earn positive Good Standing points as follows:

Positive Contributions	Points Gain
Meeting assessment deadlines	1 point each
Certificates of recognition in assemblies	2 points each
100% attendance each month	1 point per month
100% explained absences each month	1 point per month
Punctual to home room each day	1 point per week
Full and correct uniform each day	1 point per week
Attendance to after school study class	1 point each class
Extra contributions to school community	1 point for each contribution

Students start each year with zero points and will lose points by reports of breaches of College expectations:

Breach of College expectation	Points Loss
Suspension	10 points
Internal suspension	5 points
Detention	1 point
Not turning up to detention	1 point



WHAT DOES LOSS OF GOOD STANDING MEAN?

Students will not be invited to special events such as:

- Camps
- Incentive excursions
- College Ball
- Year 12 breakfast
- Graduation ceremony
- Country week

In extreme cases the College can apply for exclusion from school. Alternative educational options will be considered if the situation has become untenable.

Process for monitoring Good Standing:

- Home room mentor will complete checklist for uniform, attendance and punctuality daily and submit to the admin assistant at the end of each week
- Admin assistant will update the Good Standing tracker weekly
- Classroom teachers will inform admin assistant of students who have met their assessment deadlines
- Year Co will update tracker of any breaches
- Students are kept informed of their Good Standing Level at assemblies
- Staff are informed of students on probation or no good standing
